Road Fund Administration (RFA)

Overview:

The RFA was established by an Act of Parliament (Act 18 of 1999), and manages the Namibian road user charging system to secure and allocate sufficient funding for the achievement of a safe and economically efficient road sector.

To achieve a safe and economically efficient road sector in Namibia.



Roads Authority (RA)

Overview:

Roads Authority was established in Terms of Section 2 of the Roads Authority Act, Act No. 17 of 1999. The Authority became fully operational on 1 April 2000. The Roads Authority is responsible for the management of Namibia's road network with a view of achieving a safe and efficient road sector.

Vision:

To be an adequate, sustainable, safe and cost-effective roads sector. We are sensitive to regional and National socio-economic needs in pursuit of Vision 2030.



Roads Contractor Company (RCC)

Overview:

Established by an Act of Parliament (Act 14 of 1999) which was amended in 2002, the RCC undertakes construction or maintenance of roads as well as buildings, bridges, waterworks, dams, reservoirs, tunnels, canals, aqueducts, irrigation works, harbours, aerodromes, railways and other infrastructure.
