The Road Fund Administration (RFA)'s primary objective in issuing this invitation is to enter into agreement with a successful bidder who will achieve the following:

- 1) Develop, and Print customer service and product knowledge training course material tailored to the RFA Services (in line with the RFA objectives, mandate, vision, mission, and core values).
- 2) Conduct customer service and product knowledge training to the RFA front line staff (across the country at three towns which are centrally located to accommodate the RFA clusters i.e., Southern, Central and Northern Clusters.
- 3) Conduct <u>pre and post training</u> knowledge assessment in order to demonstrate improvement on the customer service and product knowledge gained through training, reports to be submitted.
- 4) Issue attendance certificates to the participating front-line staff.
